



"Jesus does not separate from us, but has opened the way for us, anticipating our final destination; the encounter with God the Father, in whose heart there is a place for each one of us. So, when we experience fatigue, bewilderment and even failure, let us remember where our life is headed. We must not lose



sight of the destination, even if we run the risk of overlooking it, of forgetting the final questions, the important ones: where am I going? Where am I walking towards? What is it worth living for? Without these questions, we compress our life into the present, we think we must enjoy it as much as possible and end up living day by day, without purpose, without a goal. Our homeland, instead, is in heaven (Phil 3:20); let us not forget the greatness and the beauty of our detination! *Pope Francis*
