“HAPPY FATHER’S DAY...!”

DAY FOR LIFE – JUNE 18TH 2023: The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. In England, Wales, Scotland and Ireland, the Day for Life is celebrated on the third Sunday of June. The theme is ‘Listen to Her’ and focuses on post-abortion trauma and the impact of abortion primarily on women, but also men and others. Each year a message is released. But the 2023 message is unique... the bishops have given it over to a Catholic woman who has had an abortion to share her experiences. Often the voices of women who have had an abortion are silent in Church and in society. The hope is that this will help break this silence and offer further opportunities for healing and reconciliation. PRAYERS FOR POPE FRANCIS: Pope Francis was released from Gemelli Hospital on Friday morning following his abdominal surgery on 7 June, and has returned to the Vatican. As he left the hospital, Pope Francis greeted those present, pausing for a moment for some salutations. The Pope’s surgeon, Dr. Sergio Alfieri said, **“The Pope is well, even better than before!”**

JUBILEE YEAR 2025: Vatican announces motto of Jubilee Year... 'Pilgrims of Hope' Jubilee Year will take place in line with the norm of leaving a 25-year gap between each one. The Jubilee Year is a special year of grace... Traditionally, it begins just before Christmas and ends on the Epiphany of the following year.



Jubilee 2025: Conversion:

The spiritual dimension of the Jubilee, which calls for conversion, should also embrace the fundamental aspects of our life in society as part of a coherent whole. In the realization that all of us are pilgrims on this earth, which the Lord has charged us to till and keep (cf. Gen 2:15), may we never fail, in the course of our sojourn, to contemplate the beauty of creation and care for our common home. It’s hoped that the coming Jubilee Year will be celebrated and experienced with this intention too. Growing numbers of men and women, including many young people and children, have come to realize that care for creation is an essential expression of our faith in God and our obedience to his will.

Jubilee 2025: Guidelines to Come: As is customary, the Bull of Indiction, to be issued in due course, will contain the necessary guidelines for celebrating the Jubilee of 2025. Pope said, **“In this time of preparation, I would greatly desire that we devote 2024, the year preceding the Jubilee event, to a great “symphony” of prayer. Prayer, above all else, to renew our desire to be in the presence of the Lord, to listen to him and to adore him.”**
