FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTIONS: On First Fridays, there will be an opportunity to be with the Lord with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 3pm to 6.15pm followed by Holy Mass.



WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS & THE ELDERLY: It will be celebrated on July 23, 2023. Pope Francis has chosen "His mercy is from age to age..." a passage from the Gospel of Luke, as the theme for the 2023 celebration of the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. On this world day, Francis will celebrate Mass in St. Peter's Basilica.

Francis chose the theme -- which is a line from Mary's Magnificat in the first chapter of Luke, to tie the celebration of the World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly to World Youth Day, which will be celebrated just over a week later, in Lisbon, Portugal.

The theme for the youth gathering Aug. 1-6 is "Mary arose and went with haste" from Luke 1:39, and it describes how Mary sets out to visit her elderly cousin Elizabeth and "proclaims, in the Magnificat, the strength of the alliance between young and old."

Francis celebrated the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in 2021 and decreed that it be observed each year on the Sunday closest to the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents.

PILGRIM STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA: The Pilgrimage Statue of Our Lady of Fatima along with the relics of Saints Jacinta & Francisco will arrive in Tenby on July 29th & 30th. All are welcome to visit.

Programme of events for Saturday 29th: 9.50am: the Procession of the Statue of Our Lady of Fatima and the Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco; Holy Mass at 10am; Rosary; Confessions; Veneration of the Relics; 12 noon Lunch; 1.30pm Documentary Film on Fatima: Message of Hope; 2.00pm: Talk on the Message of Fatima; Divine Mercy Chaplet; Enrolment and Investiture of the Brown Scapular; Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament; Chaplet of Adoration and Reparation; Benediction; Vigil Mass at 5.30pm. **NB: If there is a good number to visit, we can think of arranging a common transport. Speak to Fr. Paul.**
