Youth Day, which will be celebrated just over a week later, in Lisbon, Portugal. The theme for the youth gathering Aug. 1-6 is <u>"Mary arose and</u> <u>went with haste</u>" from Luke 1:39, and it describes how Mary sets out to visit her elderly cousin Elizabeth and <u>"proclaims, in the Magnificat, the</u> <u>strength of the alliance between young and old."</u> Pope Francis celebrated

the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in 2021 and decreed that it be observed each year on the Sunday closest to the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents. <u>Let us celebrate all the</u> <u>Grandparents & the Elderly in our parish & pray for them. Kindly proceed to the Parish Hall after</u> <u>10am Holy Mass to felicitate the Grandparents & the Elderly of our Parish.</u>
