“There is no need to worry and fret, for our story is firmly in God’s hands. We are heartened by Jesus’ invitation not to fear. Indeed, at times we feel imprisoned by a feeling of distrust and anxiety. It is the fear of failure, of not being acknowledged and loved, the fear of not being able to accomplish our plans, of never being happy, and so on. And so, we scramble to look for



solutions, to find a space in which to emerge, to accumulate goods and wealth, to obtain security. And how do we end up? We end up living anxiously and constantly worrying. Instead, Jesus reassures us: Do not be afraid! Trust in the Father who wants to give you all you truly need. He has already given you his Son, his Kingdom, and he always accompanies you with his providence, taking care of you every day. Fear not: this is the certainty that your hearts should be attached to! Fear not: a heart attached to this certainty. Fear not.” Pope Francis

WORLD YOUTH DAY: At the conclusion of the final Mass for World Youth Day, Pope Francis expressed his deep gratitude for every person who made “this grace-filled event” possible and announced an Asian country as the next location for World Youth Day in 2027. Before making the excitedly-awaited announcement that the next



World Youth Day will take place in Seoul, South Korea, **“moving from the western edge of Europe to the Far East,”** Pope Francis expressed gratitude to all those who have made WYD2023 in Lisbon possible. There is an expression, he said, that we have heard frequently during these days: “Thank you,” or rather, “Obrigado.” Gratitude was the core value of the Pope’s Angelus message after the Holy Mass concluding World Youth Day in Lisbon. **DESIRE TO**

GIVE IN RETURN: “...That obrigado not only conveys a sense of gratitude for what we have received but also the desire to give in return,” the Holy Father explained, highlighting how much each pilgrim has received “in this grace-filled event.” “Now, as we return home, the Lord makes us, in turn, feel the need to share and to give, to bear witness joyfully and eagerly to the good that God has poured into our hearts.”

ASSUMPTION – A DAY OF OBLIGATION: The Solemnity of the Assumption of Blessed Virgin Mary is on Tuesday, 15th. It’s a Day of Obligation. Holy Mass in Haverfordwest is at 10am and the evening Holy Mass is in Narberth at 5pm.

57TH WORLD DAY OF PEACE – THEME: ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE & PEACE... The Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development has revealed the theme of World Day of Peace, which will touch on **“Artificial Intelligence and Peace.”** The press release noted the “remarkable advances made in the field of artificial intelligence” and how they “are having a rapidly increasing impact on human activity, personal and social life, politics and the economy.” In this context, Pope Francis will call “for an open dialogue on the meaning of these new technologies, endowed with disruptive possibilities and ambivalent effects.” Every January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, the Church celebrates the World Day of Peace. The recurrence was established by Pope Paul VI in 1967, instituting a long tradition of messages from the Holy Father exhorting all people to reflect on important subjects in relation to the work of building peace.
