"Mary's secret is humility. It is her humility that attracted God's gaze to her. The human eye always looks for grandeur and allows itself to be dazzled by what is flashy. Instead, God does not look at the appearance. God looks at the heart (cf 1 Sam 16:7) and is enchanted by humility. Humility of heart enchants God. Today, looking at Mary assumed into heaven, we can say that humility is the way that leads to Heaven. Today, then, let us ask ourselves, each one of us in our heart: how am I doing with humility? Do I seek to be recognized by others, to affirm myself and to be praised, or do I think rather about serving? Do I know how to

listen, like Mary, or do I want only to speak and receive attention? Do I know how to keep silence, like Mary, or am I always chattering? Do I know how to take a step back, defuse quarrels and arguments, or do I always want to stand out? Let us think about these questions: how am I doing with humility...?" Pope Francis

POPE ENTRUSTS PRAYERS FOR PEACE TO MARY ASSUMED INTO HEAVEN: Pope Francis, following the Angelus on the feast of the Assumption, said, "We entrust to Mary, Assumed into Heaven, our supplication for peace in Ukraine and in all regions." He lamented that there are so many areas of the world afflicted by war, places where "the din of weapons covers up attempts at dialogue" and "the right of force prevail over the force of right." "But let us not be discouraged," the Pope said. "Let us continue to hope and pray, for it is God, it is He who guides history, who hears us."
