JUBILEE 2025: SHARING FAITH IN SMALL GROUPS: Pope Francis invites the Church to be prepared for the Jubilee Year 2025 with a particular focus on the prayer 'Our Father.' How important a prayer the Lord's Prayer is to us as Christians...! "Why don't we celebrate our FAITH?" Have you ever asked that question? What does my faith mean to me? What do I do with my faith and because of my faith? Do I really celebrate my faith? How do I do that? The early church, which is our root, had several small communities praying together and supporting each other in their given hostile scenario (Acts 2:42). We are invited to do the same to



celebrating the joy of our faith by forming small prayer groups and sharing our faith, enjoy some refreshments for mind and body along with the spiritual one. The booklet "WE DARE TO SAY" is there help us to explore the depth of the Lord's Prayer as a preparation for the Jubilee 2025. It is a guide to pray in groups. You have a copy now for you and your family. Don't let it gather dust but read it. **The plan is that we will hold a monthly session reflecting and praying on each session given in the book. The sessions will be after Sunday Mass.** The date will be announced well in advance. Meanwhile also consider forming a small prayer group with your friends and acquaintances, not just to fulfil this process but as a new way forward to live our faith. **We can do it...!**

LENTEN BOWL: The Liturgy of the Eucharist on Maundy Thursday begins with the Procession of the Gifts. The Missal instructs that the collection of gifts and money today be for the poor (14). *It is appropriate to include gifts collected during Lent as the fruits of penance.* During this procession the Ubi Caritas (Where charity and love is...) is sung. *Therefore, remember to place the "Lenten Bowl" on your dining table where the gifts & money for the poor can be collected.*

<u>MISSION - APF BOXES:</u> The boxes are due in now for counting. Please leave them in the sacristy. Those who haven't taken a box, please do ask Anne Hancock or Fr. Paul. **Don't worry if you don't have coppers or change.** The slot takes notes too...! And, it will be easier to carry as well...!

EASTER EGGS FOR PATCH: A box will be available in the porch if you would like to donate an Easter Egg to PATCH. The last day for donation would be March 17th so they can be taken to PATCH for distribution in time for Easter. With many thanks for your generosity in previous years.

ST. PATRICK: On Thursday 14 March in Westminster Hall, MPs held a debate on St Patrick's Day and the contribution of the Irish diaspora to the UK. Rebecca Long Bailey, the Labour MP proposed the motion. Bishop Paul McAleenan, who was born in Belfast sent MPs a message, celebrating St Patrick and the Irish Catholic contribution to the Church in England and Wales. Bishop's statement reads, "As the Feast of St Patrick approaches, we have cause both to commemorate the historic evangelisation efforts of that 5th-century Christian missionary-bishop in bringing Christianity to Ireland, and to celebrate the great breadth, depth and wealth of the contribution of the Irish diaspora to the UK over the many centuries since. The Irish Catholic contribution, both to the Catholic Church in England and Wales and to wider British life and community, has been tremendous. Since the large-scale immigration of Irish people to Great Britain in the 19th century, Catholic churches and communities throughout England and Wales have benefited hugely from the contributions of numerous Irish clergy, religious and laity. The Irish witness in our wider society has been similarly significant - many of us can readily recall having our loved ones cared for by Irish nurses, our children coached by Irish teachers, and our social life sponsored by Irish songs and spirits. As the Feast of St Patrick approaches, and as our public and political debate around issues like immigration and integration so often descends into a zero-sum game of fear, suspicion and prejudice, now is surely a good opportunity to celebrate the remarkable contribution of the Irish diaspora to British life and society as an example not least of the achievements of immigration and integration."
