**EASTER VIGIL:** The Easter Vigil is the high point of the Easter Triduum celebrating the Resurrection of Jesus. It is the "Mother of All Vigils" and Easter Sunday is the greatest of all Sundays. The season of Easter is the most important of all liturgical times, which Catholics celebrate as the Lord's resurrection from the dead, culminating in his Ascension to the Father and sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. On this holy night, the Church keeps watch, celebrating the Resurrection of Christ in the sacraments and awaiting his return in glory. The Easter Vigil is the longest service of the year, and it is when catechumens receive the Catholic Sacrament of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion on the same night. Baptised members of different denominations enter into Full Communion with the Catholic Church on this night.
